Further information for the participants of the 2nd CAM Race.

1. RACE INFORMATION

1.1 Programme Lauwersoog

Friday 10 July 2026:

- 18:00 – 19:00 : Skippers' meeting at the WEC, in the outer harbors of Lauwersoog.
- After the skippers' meeting, there will be a communal meal at restaurant 'Schierzicht', located in the outer harbor of Lauwersoog.

Saturday 11 July 2026:

- 09:00 : Start of the first starting group.

1.2 Programme in Larvik (Stavern)

Thursday 16 July 2026:

The prize-giving ceremony of the 22nd CAM Race will take place in the harbor building and will be followed by a barbecue/meal. All crew members of the participating boats will receive a free admission ticket for this event. Other interested parties can purchase a ticket for the barbecue/meal at the race office.

Programme:

- 16:00 Start of the race in open boats for the Overall Winner in the harbor.
- 17:00 Prize-giving ceremony of the Colin Archer Memorial Race 2026.

Followed by the BBQ/meal.

2. Harbor Information Lauwersoog

Lauwersoog is a small village with a large fishing harbor outside the lock and a marina with 300 berths inside the lock. The race office is located in the marina. There is also an extensive campsite with full facilities. Lauwersoog lies on the north coast of the Netherlands, about 10 miles from the North Sea, and is reached via the Westgat and the Zoutkamperlaag. See chart 1812, Wadden Sea Eastern Sheet.

2.1 Approaching from the Sea

Boats coming from the sea can obtain information about conditions in the Westgat from the Schiermonnikoog Coastguard via VHF channel 5.

2.2 Passing through the Lock

When entering the fishing harbor, the lock must be notified via VHF channel 64. This lock must be passed to reach the marina. Lock opening hours:

- Monday to Saturday: 07:00 – 19:00.
- Sundays and public holidays: 08:00 – 20:00.

Note: The last lockage starts half an hour before closing time. Boats arriving at the lock after closing time must contact the harbor authorities via VHF channel 11. If no contact can be made, vessels must find a berth in the recreational section of the outer harbor. Passage to the marina should then be made at the earliest possible opportunity.

2.3 Identification of CAM Participants

Identification of participants is often a problem. Therefore, skippers are urgently requested when entering the marina to contact the shore captain via VHF channel 88, callsign 'Colin Archer'. A berth will then be assigned to you.

2.4 Berth Fees

Skippers of boats arriving before Saturday 4 July 2026 must report to the harbormaster for a berth and must report to the race office no later than Thursday 9 July 2026 at 09:00. The berth fee due in the marina (inner harbor) must be settled with the harbormaster. In the marina, one overnight stay is free of charge.

Skippers are strongly requested, if necessary, to refuel with diesel immediately upon arrival. This is possible at the rear of the marina. Fresh water is available on all pontoons. Petrol can be obtained at a petrol station located 500 meters away. The marina has a laundry; in the event of excessive demand, the nearby campsite can be used. Internet access is available. The marina offers free wireless internet.

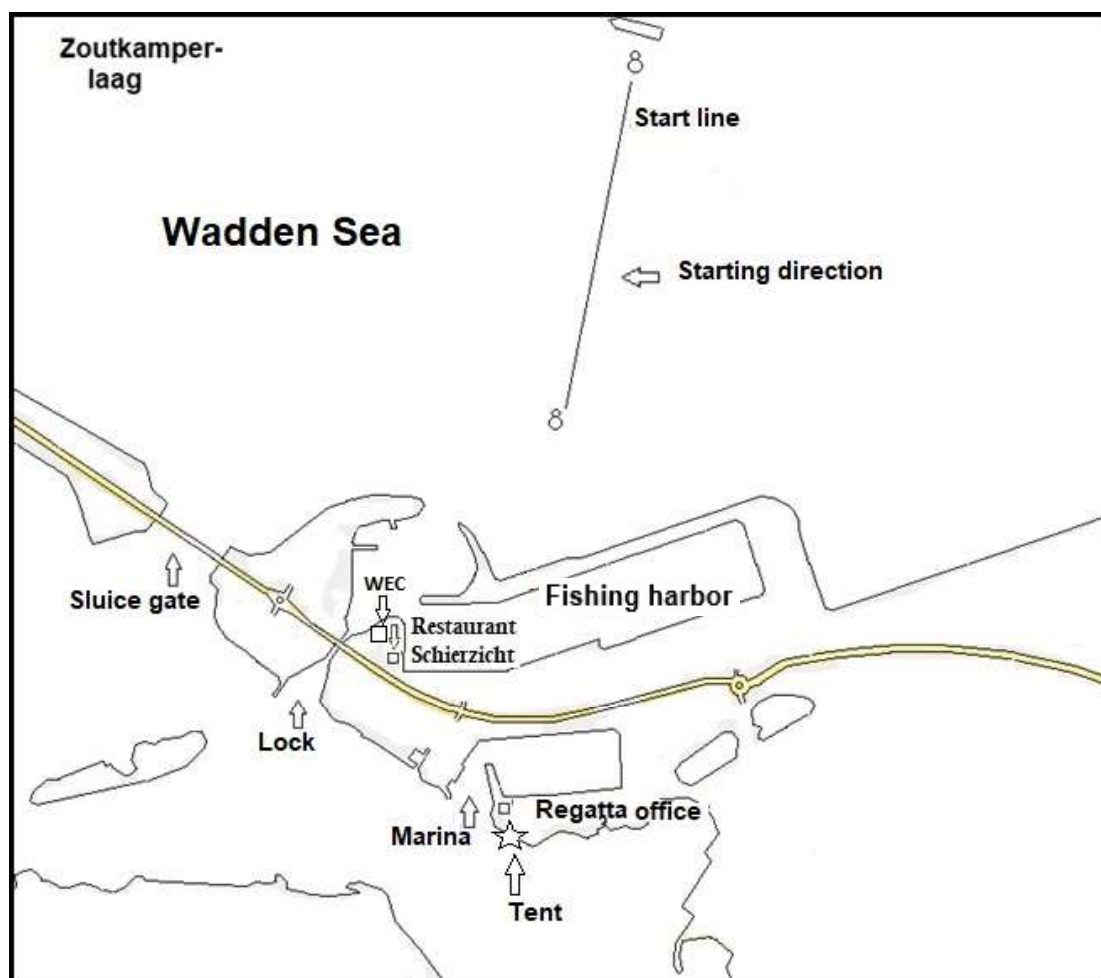
For the night of Friday to Saturday, 10/11 July 2026, CAM Race participants are not required to pay berth fees in the outer harbor of Lauwersoog.

2.5 Shifting to the Outer Harbor

On Friday, 10 July 2026, participants will be shifted to the outer harbor. You are required to be on board from 09:00 onwards, then await the instructions of the shore captain and, once received, follow them strictly. This may sound strict, but the lock in Lauwersoog is small and the participating boats are becoming increasingly larger.

Keep a listening watch on channel 88 for any further information. On average, 6 to 7 boats can pass through the lock at one time.

Saturday morning is not an option, as other vessels will be locked through, and these have priority over participants in the CAM Race.

3. Harbor Information Stavern

Stavern is part of the municipality of Larvik. Although the town of Larvik itself is fairly small, the municipality of Larvik is quite extensive. The municipality has now been merged with Lardal. It extends 50 km to the north and 15 km to the southeast. Approximately 46,000 inhabitants live in the municipality of Larvik, the "Riviera of eastern Norway." The town lies at the end of the Larviksfjord, which is 0.5 to 1 nautical mile wide, and is easily approached from the sea.

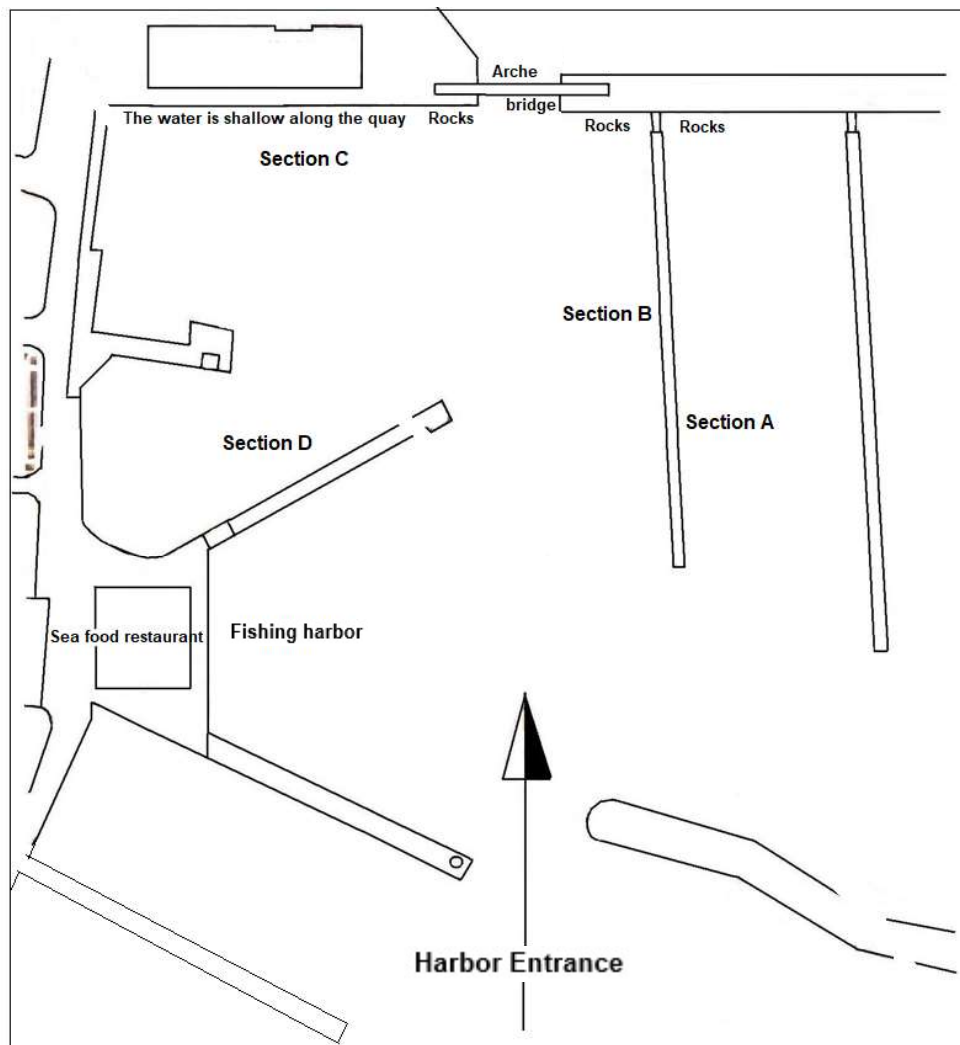
The town of Larvik does not have adequate facilities to accommodate a large number of boats. For this reason, the race office and all facilities related to the race are located in the marina at Stavern, situated at the entrance to the Larviksfjord on the west side. Note that Larvik and Stavern are not within walking distance of each other (8 km). Transport to and from Larvik is by bus or taxi.

Upon arrival in the harbor, you must take up a berth as described in rule 10.5 of the Sailing Instructions.

3.2 Customs / Immigration

While entering the harbor, the Q flag must be flown. The import of certain goods is subject to limits; see the information available online. Submitting a customs declaration at the customs office is mandatory if you have goods to declare. On-board inspection is possible. Forms can be provided at the race office.

3.3 Drinking Water

Drinking water is available on the quay of Stavern Marina.

3.4 Fuel

Fuel is available in the marina.

3.5 Sanitary Facilities

Toilets and showers are available.

3.6 Household Waste

Several waste containers are located on the pier.

3.7 Internet

Wireless internet is available in the harbor.

4.1 Telephone

The international dialing code for Norway is 0047. Norway does not use area codes; all telephone numbers consist of an eight-digit subscriber number.

4.2 Repairs

The race office can assist in arranging help for sail, engine, and electronics repairs.

4.3 Weather

Reports Channels for weather forecasts for small craft:

- **Telenor Kystradio**, coastal radio – broadcasts local weather reports via VHF, channel 16 and a local working channel, 5 times per day at 09:00, 12:00, 15:00, 18:00, and 21:00.
- **NRK Vær – NRK** broadcasts weather reports in cooperation with the Meteorological Institute. The broadcast runs throughout the day. Reception via DAB+ digital radio (no FM). Forecasts are updated 3 to 5 times per day.
